About this survey

This survey has been created on behalf of partners across the local health and care system. We are working closely together, as NHS organisations, local councils, Healthwatch, the faith sector, voluntary sector and community organisations to make sure that the views of all Bradford District and Craven communities are understood.

What will happen to my information?

The information you share in this survey will be used to help make plans for how we will deliver the COVID-19 vaccination programme in Bradford District and Craven.

We will produce reports that will include information about what people tell us and about the different groups of people who took part. We will not ask for your name or contact details, and we will not share any information that could identify you.

About the vaccine

A coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine has been approved for use in the UK.

The vaccine has met strict standards of safety, quality and effectiveness set out by the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA).

Other vaccines are being developed. They will only be available on the NHS once they have been thoroughly tested to make sure they are safe and effective.

Working in partnership to engage our communities



Key messages about the survey:

This survey aims to help the local NHS understand people's current thoughts and questions about the COVID-19 vaccine.

Even if you don't know much about the vaccine or are feeling confused, we want to understand this.

The survey is completely anonymous, we don't ask for your name or any other details. We do ask questions about your age, ethnicity and other characteristics – this is to help us make sure we're hearing from people who represent our diverse communities and to understand how people's views vary.

No questions are compulsory – you can skip any questions that you don't want to answer.

The survey is very short, and will only take a couple of minutes to complete.

Understanding what you think will help us to develop the right kind of information to answer your questions. This insight will help NHS planners to set up the vaccine in a way that works for our communities.

The survey will run for several weeks and we will be looking at the responses every week, to understand what people think and to develop information that answers your questions as quickly as possible.

We are working with partner organisations including local community organisations that are supporting people to answer this survey and helping us hear from as many people as possible.

We recognise that not everyone can answer a survey online, but we hope that this will give us a good starting point as we develop information and plan for how we will engage communities more widely once the vaccine is available.
