

## Food Access and Provision for Vulnerable and Self Isolating Patients/Public

- Anyone living in Bradford who requires help/support around food access and availability, should be signposted to **Bradford Council** on **01274 431000** in the first instance and from there follow the prompts where they can explain their situation. From here, the best method of food supply and provision can be enabled by a team of BMDC volunteers.

It's also worth any one identifying as "vulnerable" to register with the gov.uk site (see link below) – if patients/public are unable to get through to the local council service.

- Below are the links to the **Updated Meals and Food Provision** for Bradford and Keighley which can be shared with the public and patients for their information.

A lot of the meal providers have had to adjust their services -i.e. either suspend them or offer a takeout service to people who need food provision in response to the Covid19 guidance. Some may be offering a home delivery service via volunteers but need to check with each provider first. It is a self-referred system, offering a free or pay as you feel service. Please note these services can change quickly and every endeavour is made to keeping these changes updated.
